

PUNISHMENT PROVISIONS

Students or groups of students found guilty of ragging, whether on or off campus, will be subject to one or more of the following punishments:

- **Debarment from Exams:** Prohibition from appearing in any sessional tests or university examinations, or withholding of results.
- **Suspension from Classes:** Suspension from attending classes and loss of academic privileges.
- **Revocation of Scholarships:** Withdrawal of scholarships and other benefits.
- **College Suspension:** Temporary suspension from the college.
- **Cancellation of Admission:** Permanent cancellation of admission to the institution.
- **Debarment from Representation:** Prohibition from representing the institution in any national or international events, such as meets, tournaments, or youth festivals.
- **Hostel Suspension/Expulsion:** Suspension or expulsion from hostel accommodations.
- **Expulsion from the Institution:** Permanent expulsion from the institution and prohibition from admission to any other institution.
- **Legal Action:** Imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years, a fine, or both, as per the law.
- **Collective Punishment:** If the individuals responsible for ragging cannot be identified, the institution may impose collective punishment on the students involved.

These policies and measures are in place to maintain a safe and respectful academic environment at MBITS.
