

RAGGING

Ragging is defined as any of the following actions committed by a student or group of students:

- **Verbal or Physical Abuse:** Any conduct, whether verbal or written, or any action that results in teasing, mistreating, or handling a fresher or any other student with rudeness.
- **Disruptive Behaviour:** Engaging in rowdy or undisciplined activities that cause or are likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm, or instil fear in any fresher or student.
- **Humiliation:** Forcing a student to perform acts they would not ordinarily do, causing shame, torment, or embarrassment, which negatively impacts their physical or mental well-being.
- **Academic Disruption:** Any act by a senior student that interferes with, disrupts, or disturbs the regular academic activities of any fresher or other student.
- **Exploitation:** Using the services of a fresher or any student to complete academic tasks assigned to an individual or group of students.
- **Financial Extortion:** Any act of extorting money or imposing financial burdens on a fresher or any student.
- **Physical Abuse:** Any form of physical abuse, including sexual abuse, assault, stripping, or forcing someone to engage in obscene acts, gestures, or any other actions that cause bodily harm or endanger health.
- **Psychological Abuse:** Any act of abuse through spoken words, emails, public insults, or any other means that derive perverted pleasure or sadistic thrill by causing discomfort to a fresher or any student.
- **Mental Health Impact:** Any action that negatively affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any student, whether intended to cause sadistic pleasure or to exert power, authority, or superiority.
