1	Enhancements are proposed in response to student feedback regarding computer and internet facilities.	The internet capacity is boosted to 15000 GB from 8000 GB considering the increased usage. 70 numbers of computers purchased additionally. Also, 5 numbers of laptops were purchased in view of the NBA process. Ensuring annual renewal of antivirus, firewall and Microsoft agreement.
2	Improvements need in sports facilities	College team for cricket and volleyball selected. Second ground for net practicing of cricket. Decided to continue collegiate athletic competitions in addition to games and also to send students for participating in intercollegiate events. Proposed to conduct an Intercollegiate Sevens football tournament in the college.
3	Enhancement of co-curricular, extra curricular and student support activities	Talent enrichment program for enhancing the involvement of students in sports and arts is going on. In every week, 2.30 pm to 4.30 pm is allotted for these activities. Staff members are assigned charges for the various events. As a motivation and interaction with alumni, talks/workshops are arranged department wise. Open quota for NCC wing started at MBITS completed 1 st year. Eleven of our students are selected for annual training camp at Kulamavu.
4	Improvements required in hostel and canteen facilities	Decided to provide one computer in the common study area. Baine Marie is provided to upgrade and maintain the quality of food. Decided to check and ensure the annual maintenance of the hostels. Increased WiFi access point, 3 numbers in Men's hostel and 2 numbers in ladies hostel. Provided one PC in common area of Ladies hostel. Random visit by the faculty to check the discipline of the students in the hostel is following. Badminton court is functioning in the ladies hostel for the girls to utilize their leisure time. To solve the problems related to food, the canteen committee has been reconstituted.
